Learning Expedition Guidelines

1) Please make sure you visit all areas of the market:

<i>Meat area</i>	<i>Produce area</i>	<i>Bakery</i>
<i>Fish area</i>	<i>Breads/Baked Goods area</i>	
<i>Diary area</i>	<i>Dry Goods aisles</i>	

2) As you go to each section, have the members of your group identify the goods they see and the people providing service (bakery, clerk, butcher).

3) As you walk through, please ensure that the children are filling out boxes #1-3 of their recording sheet.

4) Each child will have \$3. Please take them through the entire market before allowing them to choose their item. As you go around the market and they see they see items they want, encourage them to write the item and price on the post it note provided. This will allow them to make an informed choice about what they want to buy when they are finished with the tour.

5) As children are choosing items, keep in mind we will be enjoying these together as a class this afternoon. ***Children may purchase any item they choose except candy.*** Please make sure they **save their receipt** when they purchase their checkout.
